# New president takes helm at BELS meeting

The BELS annual meeting took place in Austin, Texas, on Monday, May 21, at Moonshine Patio Bar & Grill. The restaurant was a short walk from the hotel where the Council of Science Editors meeting was being held.

Once at the restaurant, we were shown to our own private small building. I guess they did not realize that we were quiet editor types and were afraid we would be too rowdy. The small side building, called the Sunday House, was rustic and quaint, with rough-hewn beams and stucco walls. Dinner was wonderful, starting with their signature "corn dog" shrimp and ending with a fabulous apple pie with maple ice cream.

Kim Berman, as the outgoing president of BELS, gave the treasurer's report and diplomate registrar's report. BELS is doing well financially. Most of the discretionary budget last year was

Listserv access is restricted to supporting BELS members (i.e., dues-paying members of BELS). Postings are not to be distributed or shared outside the listserv community. Listserv e-mail postings must not be promotional or commercial in nature, and they cannot include employment or freelance opportunities. Inappropriate language and personal attacks are not allowed. Violations of these simple guidelines will result in removal from the BELS listserv. Please keep in mind that every posting you make to the listserv will appear as an e-mail for every subscriber to the list.


